



# FULL BIBLIOGRAPHY

WELCOME TO THE full bibliography for *Original Mind: Uncovering your Natural Brilliance*. This bibliography has several interesting elements that may help you in your searches.

First, you will note that some of the entries are in blue. That indicates that they are “hyperlinked” and if you click on one it will take you directly to that article.

Secondly, at the end of each entry you will find a number (1, 2, or 3) and sometimes a star (\*) as well. The numbers refer to the level of difficulty of the entry.

1 = general reading level, comfortable for most readers.

2 = academic reading level for the reader with some science background.

3 = challenging reading level, included for the advanced scholar.

The starred entries are especially important readings and have been described in the Recommended Readings List that is also included on this webpage.

To help you navigate this bibliography, you may want to look at the Research Guidelines document, which is also included on this webpage. It addresses (1) how to be an armchair scholar from your home computer, and (2) how to dig even deeper into the topics that fascinate you by copying the bibliography onto a flash drive and taking it to a university library.

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
